- Call to Order by Gaskamp at 6:27.
- Opening Prayer offered by Gaskamp at 6:28.
- 6:30 Devotion offered by Gaskamp with a poem reading entitled “Second Birth” whose theme is that resurrection is like a second birth.
- 6:31 Gaskamp offers brief summary of last month’s meeting given that meeting’s truncated nature in duration and attendance. Subsequently last month’s meeting Minutes were approved by acclamation.
- 6:34 Gaskamp brings forth Dwelling in the Word. Re: Acts 5: 27-32. Brynn reads. Smith reads. Discussion follows. Apostles knew their ultimate fate yet they carried on. Contemplation occurs on what it means to die for Jesus. Now all the Disciples are preaching the Gospel, not just one. Resulting in more problems for the powers that be.
- 6:55-6:59 Gaskamp brings forth time for Discerning Prayer. Focus - Next strategic steps. Where do we go from here?
- 7:00 Kids Day Out presentation (Fred and Alyson Pirotina) affiliated with/service provider for Holy Family Catholic Church. Holy Family is growing and building another building. Currently there are 2 classes for each grade with plans to add classes soon. 52 children currently registered, with 26-30 utilizing care service every day. KDO feels good about relationship with Lord of Life and the respective future of each. KDO envisions a building with 6 classrooms, 1-2 offices, with a larger “great” room multi-use space with a commercial kitchen. School age kids attend Blessed Education, pre-school kids attend Kids Day Out. Art, dance, music(fine arts) themed school business plan is envisioned. KDO/BEE is promoted as a Christian based school. In depth discussion continues, many questions arise on how this could possibly work. Will be a continuing agenda item. Synod (Chicago) legal help is recognized as important and will be efforted at Synod expense.
